Check on your neighbors

In times of emergencies neighbors need to rely upon one another..get to know your neighbor **before** the hurricane..

Be Prepared

Batteries, Battery operated lights
Emergency Radios
Manual can opener
Non perishable foods
Refill medications
Have containers for ice, food & water, recommend purchasing bottled water.
Fill a clean bath-tub with water just in case.....

Snow Birds

Does a neighbor have your contact numbers?

Pets

Don't forget your pet's needs
Special dietary foods
Refill medications

Have Hygiene Products on hand
Charge cell phones before storm
Store all outdoor furniture, potted plants, outdoor decorations
Put grills on lanai and/or disconnect gas tanks until storm is ended
Keep cash on hand – ATM's may not work

Evacuation Procedures

We follow the Brevard County Emergency Evacuation Procedures. They are too numerous to print in this pamphlet, but please familiarize yourselves with the Brevard County Website. We will make an effort to provide copies at the Club House.

Fill your automobiles with gas before all storms

Take pictures of your home's interior and exterior **before** the storm...you never know when you made need it for insurance purposes.
